BOARD OF EQUALIZATION:

Mayor Glover convened the Burke City Council as the Local Board of Equalization at 7:05 PM to review the assessment records and to consider any and all appeal forms from property owners.

Water & Sewer Estimates on E 10th St:

Kent Wells owner of Wells Utilities presented the Council with an estimate to install 700 feet of sewer and water lines on E 10th St. Sewer line estimate is \$26,257.49 and the water line estimate is \$18,164.93. Kent & Wade Broome were unable to get an exact length of the project because of the weather. Kent and Wade will measure the exact length of the project and Kent will provide an updated estimate at the April regular meeting.

Tyler Van Metre speaking for the two land owners (Tyler Van Metre & Cory Smith) informed the Council that they would like to hook to the City's sewer system. The current land owners are willing to pay for 75% of the cost to have the sewer line installed if the City will pay for the other 25%. Before any decision is made both sides are in agreement to wait until Kent and Wade can get an accurate length and to make sure the sewer line will work without the City having to install a lift. This item will be on the agenda for the April regular meeting.
